

Crochet Winter Hat

This is a great project for individuals interested in learning to crochet.

If you are interested in knitting a hat, Pat can direct you to a Covenant member to support you.



Use a J hook.

Use 4 ply yarn.

Chain 63 stitches.



Double crochet in 4th stitch from end. This counts as the first double crochet.



Double crochet across. You should have 60 double crochet stitches.

Double crochet back and forth until your piece measures 10 inches in length.



Leave a 30-inch tail of yarn. Your piece should measure about 20-inches by 10-inches.)



Using a needle weave 30-inch tail in and out of top stitches. Pull tight. Make one more round on top- no need to be careful of each weave.



Now sew the side seam together.

Weave in remaining tail.

After practicing, you may want to crochet in the back loops only to give your work a ribbed look.
