Make a pinwheel! You will need paper, glue stick, tack, and a pencil (with an eraser).



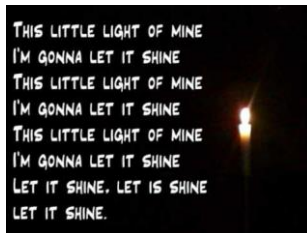

Bake a cake and light some candles! Today is the birthday of the church!

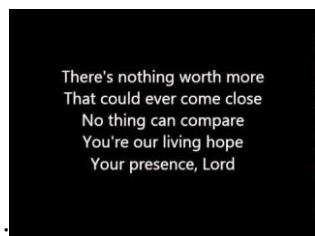
Go Forth
